## MINUTES OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY, MARCH 14, 2011

The City Council of The City of Piney Point Village held a Special Meeting on Monday, March 14, 2011 at 6:00 p.m. at 7676 Woodway, Suite 300 Houston, Texas, 77063.

1. Receive report, discuss, consider and take action on the sale of refunding bonds.

Ashley Alan with First SouthWest Group gave a summary of the recent bond refunding. The transaction will close on the 13<sup>th</sup> of April.

2. Consider and take action on the 2010 financials, the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter financial reports and financials for January 2011.

Randy Reimer summarized the finances up to current and explained that there will be a one-page summary financial report at each regular council meeting in the future.

3. Consider and take action on a discussion of forms of future Council financial reports.

4. Consider and take action on newsletter topics.

Mr. Kollenberg had drafted a letter and has asked for other topics that Council felt needed to be addressed such as the recycling program, the April 25<sup>th</sup> meeting regarding drainage and the bond issue and an email program.

5. Consider and take action on Resolution 11.03.14 to appoint a new police commissioner.
