

# Household Waste and Recycling Service The City of Piney Point Village

### **Household Waste Collection Guidelines**

Household waste must be contained in bags or personal cans up to forty-five (45) gallons not to exceed sixty-five (65) pounds. Residents are allowed to set out up to 12 items for MSW.

Cart must be out and unlocked by 7:00 A.M.

# Accepted Items for Bulk/Heavy Trash

Furniture

Carpet (up to 1 room, rolled, four feet wide and less than 50 lbs)
Household appliances (CFC's removed and certified by technician)

Hot Water Heaters must be drained

Grills must be emptied of ash or briquettes

# Unaccepted Items for Bulk/Heavy Trash

Masonry Debris Steel/Cast Iron Building Materials

Roofing Material Insulation Lawn Mowers Dirt

Sheetrock or Drywall Stone or Tile
Doors of Paneling Carpet
Tree Trunks Concrete
Water Softeners Propane Tanks

Tires

#### **Recycling Guidelines**

Household recycling must be contained in the thirty-five (35) gallon cart provided by WCA/GFL. **Cart must be out** and unlocked **by 7:00 A.M. on service day.**

#### **Service Collection Schedule**

Service Days (Household Waste) Cart Content Only - half on Monday & Thursday - other half on Tuesday and Friday

Service Days (Tree & Yard Waste) - Same as trash service day

Service Day (Bulk/ Heavy Trash) - second service day only

Service Day (Recycle) - Wednesday

Service Hours - No earlier than 7:00 A.M. & no later than 7:00 P.M.

# **Holiday Schedule**

WCA observes the following holidays: New Years Day, Christmas Day

If your service day falls on one of the observed holidays, you will be serviced on the next scheduled service day.

#### Accepted items for Recycling

Newspaper, magazines, phone books, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, file folders, paper, construction paper, cardboard boxes (they must be flattened and placed in the recycle cart), cereal and soda or beer boxes, gift boxes, wrapping paper, aluminum cans, aluminum foil, plastic bottles, jugs (#1-#7) Metal pots and pans, scrap metal like nails, screws and gutters and copper. In the event Glass bottles and jars will be accepted until which time the recycle Facility no longer deems this commodity as recyclable or no longer Accepts these items.

Please do not place recycled item in plastic bags, this could cause the items to be pulled out and sent to the land fill.

Please do not place household waste in the recycle carts, the crew will not be able to pick these up.
