ORDER NO. 18-4 VARIANCE

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE:

Section 1. The appeal of Bronwyn Swinbank is for a variance for 442 Gingham Drive to allow for a playhouse to be in the side yard at 3'6" from the property line and for the playhouse to be 21 feet tall and contain more than one story and not be fully within the rear third of the lot.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines as follows:

- (a) The variance for 442 Gingham Drive to allow for a playhouse to be in the side yard at 3'6" from the property line and for the playhouse to be 21 feet tall and contain more than one story and not be fully within the rear third of the lot, will be contrary to the public interest;
- (b) A literal enforcement of the provisions of Sections 74-244 (a)(2) and 74-244(b)(2)(a) and (b) of Chapter 74 will not result in unnecessary hardship;
- (c) The granting of the requested variance to Sections 74-244 (a)(2) and 74-244(b)(2)(a) and (b) for 442 Gingham Drive to allow for a playhouse to be in the side yard at 3'6" from the property line and for the playhouse to be 21 feet tall and contain more than one story and not be fully within the rear third of the lot), is not consistent with the spirit of the Ordinance and its general purpose and intent.
- Section 3. The action taken by the Board (i) is limited solely to this appeal and the improvements under consideration, (ii) shall not be applicable to any other appeal whether on this property or any other property and (iii) shall not alter or modify any of the terms and provisions of Chapter 74, Zoning, of the Code of Ordinances of the City or any other ordinance.
